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Pupil Premium 2020/21

At present we have 4 children in receipt of Free School Meals (FSM) and a total of 4 children who are FSM or Ever 6 FSM (have been in receipt of FSM at some point during the last 6 years).

Funding for Pupil Premium for 2020/21 is £1,320 per child.

Our pupil premium funding for 2020/21 is £6000 (based on last year's numbers).

What is unique amongst our pupil premium children?

Historically, there is some lower attainment amongst those accessing full pupil premium (not the service children). There is less engagement from home (for some children not all) with homework not completed regularly and children not being heard to read at home. Increased TA support to address this is a priority as well as finding ways to encourage parental engagement.

Support is also required for transition to secondary school. E.g. HT supported one parent with completing the Secondary School application and extra transition was made available for vulnerable pupils.

We have put the following in place to establish best practice in spending Pupil Premium.

1. High quality feedback (staff training and resources purchased)
2. Small group tuition
3. Mathematics intervention
4. Reading intervention
5. Collaborative Learning (particularly in literacy and numeracy)
6. Improvements in Phonics
7. Behaviour Interventions
8. Funding for sport/art participation
9. Funding for residential activities
10. Extended School Activities
11. Increased support in classes
